Legal impasse turned GB into a colony

BRUSSELS: The constitutional impasse has enabled military officials and bureaucrats of Pakistan to rule Gilgit-Balochistan like a colony.

This was stated by Friends of Gilgit-Balochistan at a conference titled "Constitutional Impasse and Resultant Socio-Economic Shortfall in Pakistan Occupied Kashmir and Gilgit-Balochistan" organized by the FOGB in the European Parliament.

FOGB is a caucus comprising of 43 members of the European Parliament, which supports political, humanitarian and socio-economic autonomy for Gilgit-Balochistan. The event was chaired by Mr. Adam Mouschiar, a representative of FOGB.

Speakers included Member of the European Parliament and Chairman of SAFF (South Asia Peace Forum), Mr. Ryszard Czarnecki, Vice-Chairman of International Kashmir Alliance, Executive Director of International Center for Peace and Democracy (ICPD) and Spokesperson for All Parties National Alliance (APNA), Mr. Muntaz Khan, Renowned Right Defender and representative of the Baloch community in the United Nations and the European Parliament, Mr. Mehran Baloch, and President of Institute for Gilgit-Baloch Studies (IGBS) and Director of Gilgit-Baloch National Congress (GBNC), Mr. Senge Hassan Spring, said a press release.

Mr. Czarnecki, while speaking about the socio-economic issues impacting the women of Gilgit-Balochistan, expressed shock over an increase in the crimes against women in Pakistan despite government claim of a flourishing democracy and liberal society. He said, "More than seventy percent of Pakistani women continue to face violence in the form of injuries, death, honor killing, forced nude display in public, molestation, acid burns, multi-

rape, social boycott, harassment during professional duties, denial of monetary rights, and discrimination in educational and health institutions and businesses. Further eight women including four minors are raped every day in Pakistan and in many cases; rape is authorized by the village councils to punish the women."

He said, "Denial of rights and justice to women means that extremism and terrorism is on the rise in Gilgit-Balochistan, which is alarming for the western communities. I would ask the EP to ensure that Pakistan improves the living standards of the women in Gilgit-Balochistan before expecting any grants or developmental funds." He further said, "As Vice-Chairman of FOGB, I humbly announce a pool of funds to address educational and health needs of the women of Gilgit-Balochistan. Further, a special fund will also be created for the rehabilitation of those women of Gilgit-Balochistan."

Mr. Muntaz Khan spoke about constitutional impasse and socio-economic issues in Pakistan administered Kashmir. He informed that Islamabad has taken a variety of steps to ensure its unchallengeable control on the territory leading to serious legal, moral, political and historical inconsistencies and deficiencies. Referring to the 2006 report of Human Rights Watch, he called the region a legal anomaly which is neither a sovereign country nor a province of Pakistan. He called the government of AJK a puppet of Islamabad, which has been kept on a very tight leash.

He highlighted the articles of international law which enables Islamabad to dismiss the local government at any time even when it enjoys support of the masses. He criticized Pakistan for inciting Azad Kashmir Council in Islamabad, which enjoys an absolute authority to legislate over mat-

ters, pertaining to natural resources, contraction of dams and trade and transit. He condemned the authorities for forcing the natives to declare allegiance to Pakistan to assume jobs and political offices in their own homeland.

Mr. Mehran Baloch, who is son of the Baloch national icon, Mir Khair Bux Marri, raised the issue of disappearances and extra-judicial murders in Balochistan and accused Pakistani military of killing tens of thousands of innocent civilians. He reiterated that the Baloch nation refused to accept Pakistan's hegemony and continued to struggle for freedom of their motherland.

He criticized Pakistan for establishing military cantonments in different parts of the region. He said, "In the name of industrialization, mineral exploration and economic development, hundreds of thousands of Pakistanis have received jobs in Balochistan through preferential hiring policy, which aims at changing the local demography and converting the Baloch into a minority in their own homeland."

He called Islamabad's package for Balochistan, called Aghaz, Hoopoe-e-Balochistan, an eye-wash and void of genuine political and socio-economic guarantees. In the end, he requested the European Union to support freedom struggle of Balochistan and asked Pakistani authorities to free Baloch political prisoners.

Mr. Senge Spring compared political and socio-economic status of Indian Ladakh with that in Gilgit-Balochistan and appreciated Indian efforts in restoring the demography, religions, culture, and languages of Ladakh, as well as granting political rights, freedom of speech and socio-economic activity to the Ladakhis, something which the natives of Gilgit-Balochistan only dream of.

Fire damages bridge

GHZER: A wooden bridge in the Baber Village of Punal Tehsil, Ghizer, has been damaged after it caught fire the other day. According to reports, the fire erupted due to short circuit at a nearby shop. The shop was gutted and the supporting wires of the suspension bridge were also damaged in the incident rendering it unsafe for movement. One of the ancient villages of Punal, Baber with an approximate population of around 16000 people has been cut off from rest parts of Punal. People are faced with lack of food items and other basic necessities of life.

It is the only bridge that connects Baber village with rest of the Punal. It was expected that the government will take immediate steps to repair the bridge and make it clear for people but to the disappointment of the people of Baber village government has taken no such step so far. People of Baber village are facing lack of flour and other food items, people with jobs in Ghakuch, Gilgit city and other places are worried and waiting for immediate steps from government but govt like in the past has shown no interest in solving the problem on immediate basis, said a stranded inhabitant of Baber village told this scribe while talking on phone.

The anger and depression among Baber people is increasing with each passing day on government inaction. An emergency meeting of Baber youth was held today in which an ultimatum of one week to repair the bridge was given. Pamiir Times

Funds for flood victims Red tape creates another crisis

GILGIT: Due to the inordinate delay and red tape adopted by the deputy commissioners and their subordinate staff in all the seven districts of Gilgit-Balochistan, preparing the estimates of losses incurred during the recent floods, the federal government has not released the Rs12 billion announced for launching rehabilitation work in the region.

According to reports, an amount of Rs12 billion had been sanctioned for providing assistance to the flood devastated people and their permanent rehabilitation on the demand of the Gilgit-Balochistan government (PDP). However, the deputy commissioner of the region to prepare reports and assessment of the damages of each district so that the funds could be released for the rehabilitation projects.

The assessment reports were to be submitted to the Disaster Management Authority of Gilgit-Balochistan. However, the deputy commissioners adopted the usual

bureaucratic attitude even in this hour of tragedy when thousands of people remained homeless and needed urgent assistance before the start of the winter season.

As a result, the rehabilitation work could not be started in the region even after the passage of many months. The displaced people are, in the meanwhile, living in pathetic conditions at the makeshift camps and worn-out tents without even basic necessities of life.

Whatever assistance has so far come to them was through non-governmental organizations which are also now exhausting. The lack of interest on part of the government has created a sense of despondency among the displaced persons in the region. They are now facing lack of daily-use items and life-saving drugs in the camps.

With the onset of the winter season, there is also the danger of spread of different diseases among the camp inmates, especially women, children and the elderly.

It seems that the government is not serious in ensuring the timely arrival of help to the

devastated people otherwise it could have strictly directed the deputy commissioners to prepare the reports and submit it to the authorities concerned keeping the magnitude of the crisis in mind.

The government of Gilgit-Balochistan has failed even to get its directions implemented through the deputy commissioners and as a result thousands of people are at the risk of yet another crisis that would be unfortunately man-made.

The people of the region have criticized the rulers for their complete disregard to the sufferings of the affected people. They said the rulers had been busy in looting and plundering the resources of the region besides promoting corruption and when it came to the rehabilitation of those in need, the rulers remained a silent spectator.

They asked the federal government to intervene in the matter and take action against the officials responsible for delaying the preparation of the assessment reports in order to ensure the affected people get assistance and the rehabilitation work started without further delay.

He said, "I do not like to get into politics, but I am more than happy to be a part of the UNDP and reaching out to the flood-stricken people," he said.

NATCO chief denies corruption

GILGIT: The Northern Areas Transport Company (NATCO) is a national organization with the honour of having international service but some elements in the region are unable to digest its success and frequently try to defame it by issuing statements to the local press.

However, NATCO has gained a reputation at the national level and the elements trying to defame it will never succeed in their design.

These views were expressed by Mr. Zafar Iqbal, the managing director of NATCO, while talking to this correspondent here. Discussing the problems in transporting wheat from Gilgit-Balochistan, he said that from July to September the Karakoram Highway remained closed due to the devastating rains and floods while at the end of September the supply of wheat was stopped due to non-payment of dues. Even under these circumstances, NATCO succeeded in transporting 505,310 bags of wheat to the region. He said that those who were criticizing the company actually wanted to give the contract of the wheat supply to private parties. However, he said that if the contract of the private parties, they would never be able to even transport half of the stock.

GB to participate in national games

PESHAWAR: Gilgit-Balochistan and Azad Jammu and Kashmir have been included to field their separate contingents in the forthcoming 1st National Games commencing from December 25-31.

A special aspect in this connection was made from the Prime Minister Secretary to the Chief Minister Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Ameer Haider Khan Hosi, who is also chief patron of the Organizing Committee of the Games, to include both Gilgit-Balochistan and AJK to field their separate contingents that would also be part of the March Past as well.

After inclusion of Gilgit-Balochistan and Azad Jammu and Kashmir the units in the games increased to 15 with players from Army, PAF, Navy, Railways, HEC, Police, Wapda, Punjab, Sindh, Balochistan, Islamabad, FATA, host Khyber Pakhtunkhwa will be taking part in 23 male and female games.

It would also be the first occasion in the Games since that a total of 15 flags would be carried out, indicating the unity of the nation. Prime Minister Syed Yousuf Raza Gilani will grace the opening ceremony on December 25 while President Asif Ali Zardari will be the chief guest at the closing and prize distribution ceremony.

When the Provincial Minister for Sports Syed Aqil Shah was contacted, he also confirmed high level contact was made for the inclusion of both Gilgit-Balochistan and Azad Jammu and Kashmir. "I also confirmed and discussed the same with Pakistan Olympic Association who gave a go ahead."

Another bid to jam wheel of progress

GILGIT: The federal government has reportedly decided to divert funds allocated for the development projects in Gilgit-Balochistan to the flood-affected people in the region.

If the decision is implemented, work on all the ongoing projects costing billions of rupees would be stopped while there would be no new projects in the pipeline. As a result, the wheel of development would come to a grinding halt.

The residents said that it was yet another anti-masses policy of the government to utilize the development funds for rehabilitation of the flood victims. They said the government received billions of rupees from donor agencies in the name of the flood victims but was spending the amount selectively. Instead of allocating special funds for the

to non-payment to contractors, work on a number of projects has already been abandoned. The latest decision of the federal government will further paralyze the development works besides rendering thousands of people jobless.

The residents demanded that the government should allocate more funds for the development of the region and create separate and special funds for the urgent rehabilitation of the flood victims.

He said special children would be given free education and pick and drop facility at these centres to boost enrolment and ensure that every special child get access to the centres.

Tennis star visits flood victims

ISLAMABAD: UNDP goodwill ambassador and tennis player Aisamul Haq Qureshi on his return from a one-day trip to Gilgit-Balochistan said that his visit was an eye-opener, and added that the government and the media are not projecting the right image of the floods.

On his first visit to the flood-affected regions of Gilgit-Balochistan, Ghizer Valley and Hunza, Qureshi described his whole experience as 'memorable'. "I am amused to see the people's patience. I would not be going back. If I were to put

myself in their place, I do not know what I would have done," Qureshi said, adding that the trip has made him appreciate life more than ever.

While criticizing the government and the media, Qureshi said that the message to be put back on the floods situation, "There is no news about the floods anymore and we feel as if the disaster is over. Far from it," he said.

"We are not acting as a nation; people are always aspiring to 'move out of Pakistan,'" he added. The tennis player himself

has witnessed an unbelievable year. However, he insisted that there is more to life beyond the game. "There is more to life than tennis, this trip has been an eye-opener," he said.

Qureshi shared that he had needed to assist the earthquake victims in 2005 and dreamt of making a rehabilitation centre for them, but was unable to get support from the government.

Chitrali leaders' role in Lowari Tunnel

ISLAMABAD: If you had any doubt that the political leaders of Chitral are just spineless busy hounds for protecting their own personal interests, their silence and dubious role over the government's refusal to release funds for the completion of Lowari Tunnel should leave no room for a doubt.

We have two leaders in prominent positions: Shahzad Mohammad ANA, who is also Chairman of the National Assembly standing committee on Kashmir and Gilgit-Balochistan, and Saleem Khan, the KP minister for population welfare. Besides, there is Ghulam Mohammad who was elected from Upper Chitral on the ticket of PML-Q boasting on the ser-

vice of former President Pervez Musharraf for Chitral. But after coming to power, these leaders have failed even to ensure the completion of an already materialized project.

Maybe, they play politics at the cost of the public fearing that completion of this vital project would bring political dividends to some at the cost of others - though this may not be the case.

People of Chitral have acknowledged the welfare works carried out by the former president, especially the re-launching of the dead Lowari Tunnel project and bringing it near completion. Even now when Musharraf is a component of active political history

and lives abroad, people of Chitral have raised voice in his support and invited him to run the next elections from the valley.

Those who voted for Mohiuddin and Ghulam Mohammad in the 2008 elections also expected that these two gentlemen would ensure the completion of the development projects which were initiated by Mr. Musharraf. However, they failed to meet the expectations.

On the other hand, PPP government, which never tires of claiming to be the champion of starting work on the Lowari Tunnel, so vital a project for Chitral, has now proved its credibility by stopping funds for

the tunnel. But what our so-called political leaders, especially those who had taken votes in the name of Musharraf, done in ensuring that this project is completed without any hindrance?

Now it is a big slap on their faces that a Jamat-ud-Dam (JD) leader, who is even not a resident of Chitral, has submitted an adjournment motion to the Senate Secretariat seeking debate on stoppage of work and release of funds for the project.

In response to the motion, Senator Prof Ibrahim Khan said the routine business of the house should be adjourned to discuss the vital

Lowari Tunnel project, officials told chitraliroyals.com in Islamabad. He said the tunnel was not only meant to provide all-weather road to district but was also of strategic importance for Pakistan.

He said after seven million rupees were spent by the previous government on the project and the tunnel was near completion, the present government has stopped making payment to the Korean construction company since March 2010.

As a result, the foreign consultants and engineers have left the country. He said this also brought a bad name from Pakistan in other countries. -Zar Alam Khan
