Dineen Stadium Dineen Stadium, also called Colonial Stadium, was a minor league baseball park in Brockton, Massachusetts. It opened in 1922 and was dedicated in honor of Amos Dineen, a local businessman who served as owner and business manager of the ballpark. The stadium was built on land owned by Amos Dineen at Park Square, a small, triangular, pedestrian-only park that was completed in 1916. Park Square was designed as a traffic-free square in the style of Central Park in New York City. It featured a fountain, an automobile-free park, and a circular bandstand, as well as a brick footbridge over the Franklin Street railroad line. A bandstand was added to the outfield bleachers in 1922 and a synthetic playing surface was installed the following year. Dineen Stadium served as the home of the Brockton Rox of the New England League from 1922 to 1927 and the Brockton Beavers of the Interstate League from 1926 to 1928. The ballpark also hosted home games of the amateur Brockton Rox of the Eastern League in 1923 and 1924. Dineen Stadium was demolished in 1931. The lot was transformed into a circular city park called Brockton Ballpark in 1935 and again, in 1945, into Park Square Shopping Center. The American Legion baseball fields to the north remain in use as the George C. Noonan Field.
